

Conditions of Entry and Participation – ASIX Social Changemakers Art Prize

1. **ELIGIBILITY** The ASIX Social Changemakers Art Prize is open to any person with the exception of ASIX staff or contractors and their immediate families.
2. **MEDIUM & SUBJECT** As detailed in the exhibition brief.
3. **PRIZES** One acquisitive prize of \$3,000 will be awarded on the advice of the Judging Panel. The prize winning work shall remain the property of ASIX. The artist retains copyright. ASIX must be acknowledged on any reproduction of the prize-winning work.
4. **EXHIBITION SELECTION** The Judging Panel will also select works of merit to be hung in the exhibition, held at the Weave Arts Centre. All works selected for hanging must remain on show for the duration of the exhibition. The Judging Panel's decision shall be final and no subsequent discussion will be entered into.
5. **EXHIBITION HOURS** The exhibition will be held in the Weave Arts Centre, from 13 – 22 April 2012. Admission is free. Open 7 Days: 10am–5pm
6. **SALE OF ART WORKS** All works may be for sale unless marked Not For Sale (NFS). A commission of 33.3% will be deducted from the selling price of any work sold from the Exhibition. Should GST apply to the sale of your artwork, please ensure it is included in the total selling price.
7. **NUMBER OF ENTRIES** A maximum of 2 works per artist or group (one application form per artwork). Application forms must be signed by the artist, or, alternatively, when an application form is signed on behalf of artist(s), a letter of authority must accompany the entry.
8. **PREPARATION AND SIZE OF ARTWORK** Works must be presented ready for exhibition as detailed in the brief. The artist's name, address and phone number, title of work, price or Not For Sale (NFS) must be attached to each work and clearly readable, and these details must also be provided on the Application Form.
9. **RECEIPT AND DELIVERY OF ENTRIES** As set out in the Exhibition brief **ALL APPLICATION FORMS MUST ACCOMPANY THE ARTWORK**
10. **COLLECTION OF ENTRIES NOT CHOSEN FOR EXHIBITION** Unsuccessful entrants will be notified by email and/or phone. Works not selected must be collected from Weave Arts Centre (02) 9519 5766 between Monday 23 April 2012 between 10am–5pm at their own cost. ASIX and Weave Arts Centre will not be responsible for works not collected by this time. Works not collected by 26 April 2012 will be disposed of.
11. **COLLECTION OF ARTWORKS AFTER EXHIBITION** Exhibitors must collect their works between Monday 23 April 2012 between 10am–5pm at their own cost. ASIX and Weave Arts Centre will not be responsible for works not collected by this time. Works not collected by 25 April 2012 will be disposed of.
12. **COLLECTION OF WORKS BY COURIER** Artists must organise the courier and advise Weave Arts Centre of all details – especially the name of the courier company and approximate time and date for collection.
13. **CARE AND RESPONSIBILITY** ASIX will exercise all reasonable care with works submitted, but will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any work while in its custody or in transit to and from the Exhibition.
14. **COPYRIGHT** ASIX reserves the right to photograph works exhibited in the Exhibition/Art Prize for the purpose of documentation and promotion. All

- necessary acknowledgements of authorship will be duly made.
15. INTERPRETATION OF THE RULES In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of conditions, the decision of ASIX shall be binding on all parties.
